He regularly counsels oil and gas and mining companies on obtaining and operating leases on federal and Indian lands. He also defends oil and gas companies accused of violating the False Claims Act. Additionally, Mr. Leggette counsels companies on compliance with offshore safety and environmental requirements and on insurance and indemnity issues in offshore operations.

Most recently, Mr. Leggette has spoken on legal issues facing American companies re-entering Libya in conferences in Valleta, Malta, and Tripoli, Libya. He has also presented at conferences in Vancouver, St. John's and Halifax on the policy and history of the American offshore energy program for Canadian government and business leaders.
